Project Description:

For the past 6 months, the RTF has been coordinating with the City Parks and Rec. Department to build one of the many the pedestrian bridges indentified in the recently adopted Master Plan for the Meadow Creek Valley Park/ Greenbrier Park. The RTF purchased to 2 steel I-beams from a decommissioned bridge in Waynesboro for \$4,000 and paid \$1,000 to transport them to Charlottesville. This contribution will be used as match. The Parks and Rec. Department estimates that it will need to contribute \$10,500 from their Trail Fund for lead abatement, shipping of the beams to the site, engineering, construction of concrete bridge abutments, and hiring a crane to place the beams. Altogether, these funds will pay to install the bridge's super structure.

Based on past experience, RTF estimates that it will cost roughly \$6,500 in materials and \$500 for tools and incidental costs to build a wooden deck a 70 foot long and 12 foot wide deck with handrails on top of the super structure. The Greenbrier Neighborhood Association is willing to contribute \$1,500 toward the materials costs. The RTF will cover the \$500 in tools and incidental costs and provide the labor for construction. The grant request is for \$5,000 to cover the shortfall in the material costs.
